

Stamp Out Hunger! May 12, 2007

On Saturday, May 12 Savannah-Chatham County letter carriers will collect food donations to benefit those at risk for hunger during the National Association of Letter Carriers' ([NACL](#)) 15th Annual *Stamp Out Hunger!* food drive. Helping Stamp Out Hunger! in Savannah-Chatham County is as easy as checking your mailbox. Just leave a bag of non-perishable food where your letter carrier normally delivers your mail. Your letter carrier will then pick up and deliver the food to us. Examples of non-perishable items include:

- Canned soups
- Canned meats and fish
- Canned vegetables and fruit
- Boxed goods (such as cereal)
- Pasta and Rice
