



Summer Feeding 2019

America's Second Harvest of Coastal Georgia (ASHCG) is interested in partnering with community groups and organizations to feed children who are at-risk for hunger this summer. Children who are eligible to receive free or reduced price lunch during the school year are left without this valuable resource during the summer months when schools are closed. ASHCG will provide hot, nutritious meals free of charge to children at participating sites. Eligible sites must meet certain criteria:

- Located in an area served by a school where at least 50% of the students are eligible for free or reduced price lunch
- Commit to serve meals to 45 or more children at least four days a week for free delivery
- Provide paper products (plates, spoons, forks, napkins) for each meal service
- Supervise staff to re-heat and serve meals if necessary
- Hot Meals are available if organization has no kitchen
- Attend a mandatory training session conducted by ASHCG and agree to follow rules that have been established by U. S. Department of Agriculture

ASHCG provides a variety of meal combinations for sites from the following options: breakfast, lunch, or supper.

On the Menu are great tasting kid friendly meals, with fresh fruits, and veggies.

Enrollment of participating sites will take place for a limited time.
